



AGEN AND CANAL DE GARONNE



Agen is a land of contrasts and the beating heart of the Lot-et-Garonne, 1 hour from Bordeaux.

Agen is an ancient port on the Garonne that's a small, friendly, foodie and fascinating town! It's famous for being the capital of prunes.

The Garonne and its UNESCO canal are the perfect places for a refreshing break.

Unmissable: get out of the town centre and visit the locals' pride and joy: Agen's canal bridge. It spans the majestic Garonne and is one of the biggest in Europe!

Walk or ride over the canal bridge, visit the Jacobins Church or the Fine Arts Museum.

Experiences: soak up the great outdoors with activities at **Passeligne Nature Park** or climb the Ermitage hillside for views of the old town.

BORDEAUX AND ITS PARKS

At 1 hour from Agen, Bordeaux will dazzle you with its busy terraces and leafy streets along **the Garonne River**.

Unmissable: take a walk in the many parks, the city's green lungs. Experience the Darwin ecosystem, an alternative cultural and sustainable site on the right bank in Bordeaux.

Experiences: learn how history has bound Bordeaux to its river at the **Musée Mer Marine.** Soak up the magic of Bordeaux's **parks and botanical gardens.**

Arcachon Bay (45 min train ride from Bordeaux): go on a guided tour of the "winter town", an **excursion** with an oyster farmer or a bike ride to the Dune of **Pilat**).

Book your tour with a naturalist guide at **Teich Bird Reserve**.

The **floral villages on lle de Ré**, heaven for cyclists and a bus ride from La Rochelle.

LA ROCHELLE DOOR TO THE OCEAN

La Rochelle is a seaside haven within 2 hours of Bordeaux.

Unmissable: enjoy the gentle sea breeze as you stroll around the old port and walk or ride to the incredible Les Minimes marina.

Feast your eyes on La Rochelle's towers, relics of naval maritime fortifications, and visit one of the biggest private aquariums in Europe.

Experiences: explore **mussel farming villages** near the city and look out for **migratory birds in Aiguillon Bay,** national nature reserve.
