Explore the UNESCO Creative City, Town of Art and History and World Capital of Fire Arts as you soak up Limoges and its signature enamel, porcelain, stained glass and so much more!

Unmissable: be dazzled by the world's best porcelain collection at Musée National Adrien Dubouché and the enamel pieces on display at the Museum of Fine Arts.

Experiences: take a **trip to the historical La Boucherie neighbourhood** and do a spot of shopping to treat yourself to the dinner set you've always wanted from a designer or one of the china factory stores (Bernardaud, Haviland etc.).

BRIVE AND ITS MARKET

Venture into the heart of Corrèze in Brive-La-Gaillarde, famous for its market and long-standing CA Brive rugby team.

Unmissable: Halle Georges Brassens market, Labenche art and history museum, Saint-Martin collegiate church.

Experiences: unlock the secrets of master liquorists at **Denoix distillery.** Visit villages listed as the "Most Beautiful Villages in France" near Brive such as Turenne and Collonges-la-Rouge.



PLUS...

Aubusson in Creuse to visit the Cité Internationale de la Tapisserie.

Dive into the fascinating history of Aubusson tapestry, listed as UNESCO intangible cultural Places where matches are broadcast heritage of humanity.

Venture 30 minutes from Limoges to Saint-Junien to learn the legacy of the famous French glove brand Agnelle. Visit its factory.

Try a Terra Aventura scavenger hunt with the family: "A Porcelain Wonderland" in Limoges.

Visit Reynou Park and Zoo in Le Vigen, near Limoges.

SARLAT AND ITS CRAFTS

Sarlat is a Périgord Noir Town of Art and History that has held onto its old-world charm and set the scene for countless film shoots.

Unmissable: medieval lanes and alleys, Sarlat market (one of the best in France), local craft shops.

Experiences: Sainte Marie Church lies deep in the medieval town of Sarlat and was renovated by the architect Jean Nouvel. Open its enormous doors and step into its market hall.



FOR RUGBY FANS...

If you're a fan of Tolkien and Miyazaki, take a trip to In Brive: an Escape Game "Operation Mascot" allows you to immerse yourself in the atmosphere of a rugby dressing room.
