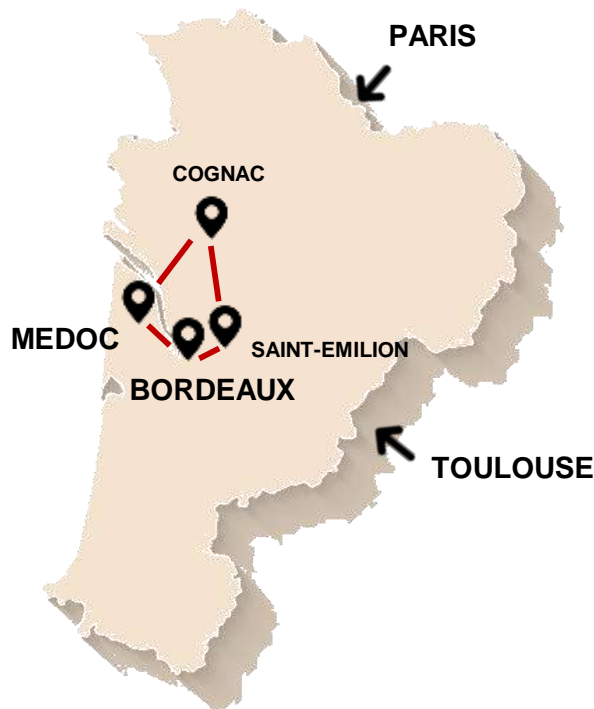

Travel back in time in medieval Saint-Émilion, the **biggest vineyard listed as UNESCO World Heritage**, 45 minutes from Bordeaux.

Unmissable: the biggest monolithic church in Europe is well worth a visit, as is **Tour du Roy tower** and the **Cordeliers cloister**.

Experiences: have an unforgettable ride on the **Train des Grands Vignobles (vineyard train)**. Go on an e-bike or segway to explore the **Saint Emilion Jurisdiction vineyard**.

COGNAC AND ITS VINEYARDS

Dive into the history of **Cognac**, the birthplace of **King François I**, 90 mins from Saint-Emilion.

Unmissable: travel back in time at **Château de Cognac** and step into the fascinating world of **leading Cognac brands**: Hennessy, Rémy Martin, Camus, Martell & Co, Meukow and more. Learn everything there is to know about the Cognac at the **Musée des Savoir-Faire de Cognac** or go on a **boat trip on the Charente**.

Experiences: explore the **Rémy Martin vineyard on a Méhari or by e-bike ride**. Find out how Cognac and Pineau des Charentes are made at the **Maison de la Vigne et des Saveurs in Archiac**.



MEDOC AND ITS CHÂTEAU WINERIES

Discover the **prestigious Médoc vineyard** and its numerous grands crus, less than 2 hrs from Cognac.

Unmissable: Pauillac Tourist and Wine House. You are now ready for the "**architecture des châteaux du Médoc**" tour, a 52 km loop where you can contemplate **more than sixty famous châteaux** including: Léoville Poyferré and Gruaud Larose.

Experiences: From Blaye and its Vauban Citadel, take the ferry to Lamarque. Admire off shore, the "**fort Paté**", vestige of the "Vauban lock" and the "**Ile Nouvelle**". You arrive in the Medoc and its vineyards that border the largest estuary in Europe.
